This papa: As our books of accounts are finalised. hence Chartered to be accountant is asking to reconcile the credit taken by us on inputs, input service and capital goods with the figures appearing in electronic credit ledger as shown on the GST portal. He has asked me to give the print out of this electronic credit ledger. But I tried to download the same. I went to website www.gst.gov.in and logged in our firm username and password. I tried to download the electronic credit ledger for the previous financial year. But the portal allows me to download only this ledger consecutive months only. Hence, I could not download in one go and we have to download April to September of previous financial year and then October to March of previous financial year. Even we are also failed to understand the logic behind such restriction. If we can download in one go then it will easy for us. Use of such advanced technology is for ease of doing business. On the contrary, it is creating hurdles and time consuming. We have already said in our earlier update also that work should get smoothen and take less time with use of technology. But GST portal is creating hurdles and increases time consumption for accomplishing any task. Downloading complete year figures seems to be very easy task with any type of software. Such restrictions should be avoided. Even this hurdle has created problems for portal also. The time duration spent by me on portal has increased. As number of user working together are limited on this portal, hence it is unnecessary increasing usage.
